Chair's Report

- A group went to see the proposed site for the new JCAP downtown apartments at Wilson Park. Kevin, Susan, Dick, Jeremy walked around the block. The project has cleared the planning commission but this does not necessarily mean it will be built. JCAP had been approved for assisted living, and switched their plan to something else.
- The marathon has been moved to September, near the end of the month (dates unknown).
- We now have a grant to do a mailing for our annual meeting. With 1,300 households, this is a better way to spread the word than walking door to door. IT will be a once-a-year mailing.
- Sharon will look into how we get a mailing list labels

Treasurer's report

- Ending May 11, we have \$3,463. 17 to 18 hundred is for the garden, the rest is ours. The general fund has about 1100 dollars.
- We need to start the annual meeting newsletter early so as not to rush it.
- Date for the thrift sale is September 12. Same as the International Fall Fest.
- Discussion of potentially having maps for the thrift sale online or paper.
- Discussion of potential activities and fundraisers: parties at the park, ice cream socials, historic home tours (even virtual?)
- We can start the discussion of the parking app at the annual meeting. Other items: the thrift sale, marathon, long-term plan, city information, Wilson Square development, the UWEC Visitor Center, the Wilson Park fountain.
