- 2. Chair Report: Susan
 - a. Progress is being made on the By-Laws, plan to have completed by Annual Meeting
 - b. Progress in Home Tour, Demmler Gardens
 - c. Survey has been done of the TWNA with results being evaluated
- 3. Steering Committee Minutes from June are on the website.
- 4. Treasurer's Report: Susan (info from Sharon)
 - a. Presently \$4,526.70 in the account
 - Received 2 donations for the home tour
 - c. Third Ward airbnb owner donates part of income to TWNA \$60 received
- 5. City Council Report: none
- 6. UWEC Report: Jake Wrasse
 - a. New Science/Health Science building
 - WI State Budget has approved \$340.3 million for the Science/Health Science Building. Next step is to call for bids.
 - ii. Parking study has to be proposed to City Council, steps are Parks& Waterways Comm mtg in late July, Planning Comm Mtg in earlyAug with City Council approval later in August.
 - iii. Construction will take 2 2.5 years, then Phillips will be dismantled with return of some parking spaces that were eliminated with the new Davies building.
 - iv. Bird friendly building recommendations have been incorporated into this building.
 - b. Orientation to occur over the next several weeks 500 persons/day (incoming students and families)
- 7. ECPD Report: Ryan Dahlgren (south district commander)

- a. Responding to concerns about protection for vehicles traveling on Thorp Drive from going down the steep slope into the river especially in wintersome rocks have been placed. He will do more research as to why not more protection for the whole drive.
- b. Questions about bike patrol states staffing issues have made the dept back off from this hope to return once staffing is back at quotas.
